Every student will have to prepare for both the psychomotor and cognitive exams (1).The practical examination is going to be administered by the state EMS Office, so it is advisable that a student must contact his or her corresponding course instructor to know about the practical test.

On January 1, 2017, the NREMT implemented the new scenario based psychomotor exam. Paramedic candidates are tested on (6) skills, including an integrated out-of-hospital (IOOH) scenario. The scenario will reflect either a pediatric, geriatric or adult patient.

National Registry psychomotor examinations are standardized examinations administered in a variety of locations across the United States. EMR and EMT psychomotor exams are coordinated by either the State EMS Office or by educational institutions under authority of the state. All advanced level psychomotor exams (Advanced EMT and Paramedic) are authorized and monitored by an official National Registry Exam Representative.
